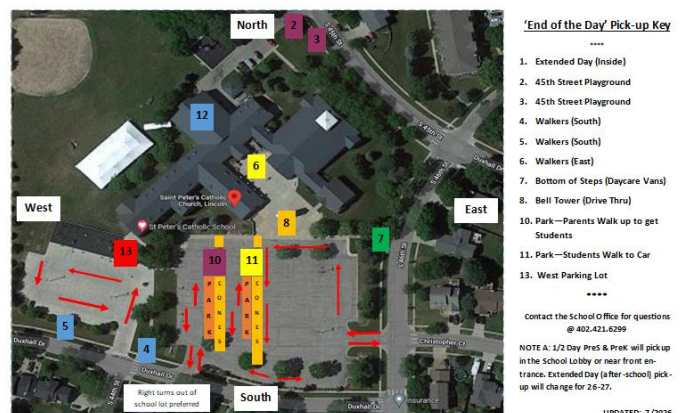
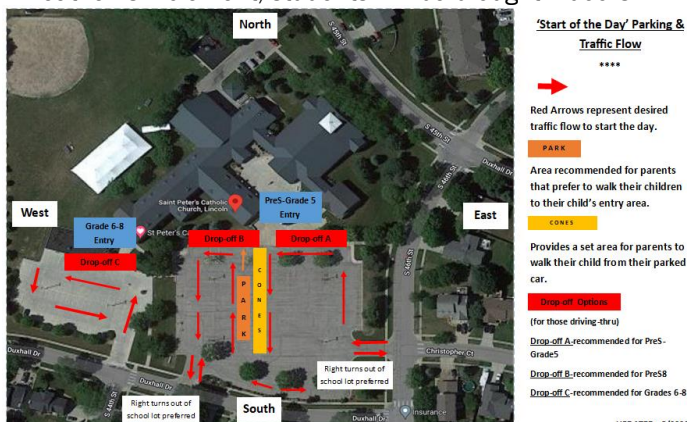
Tomorrow/School Year

- **School Bathrooms** – Completed.

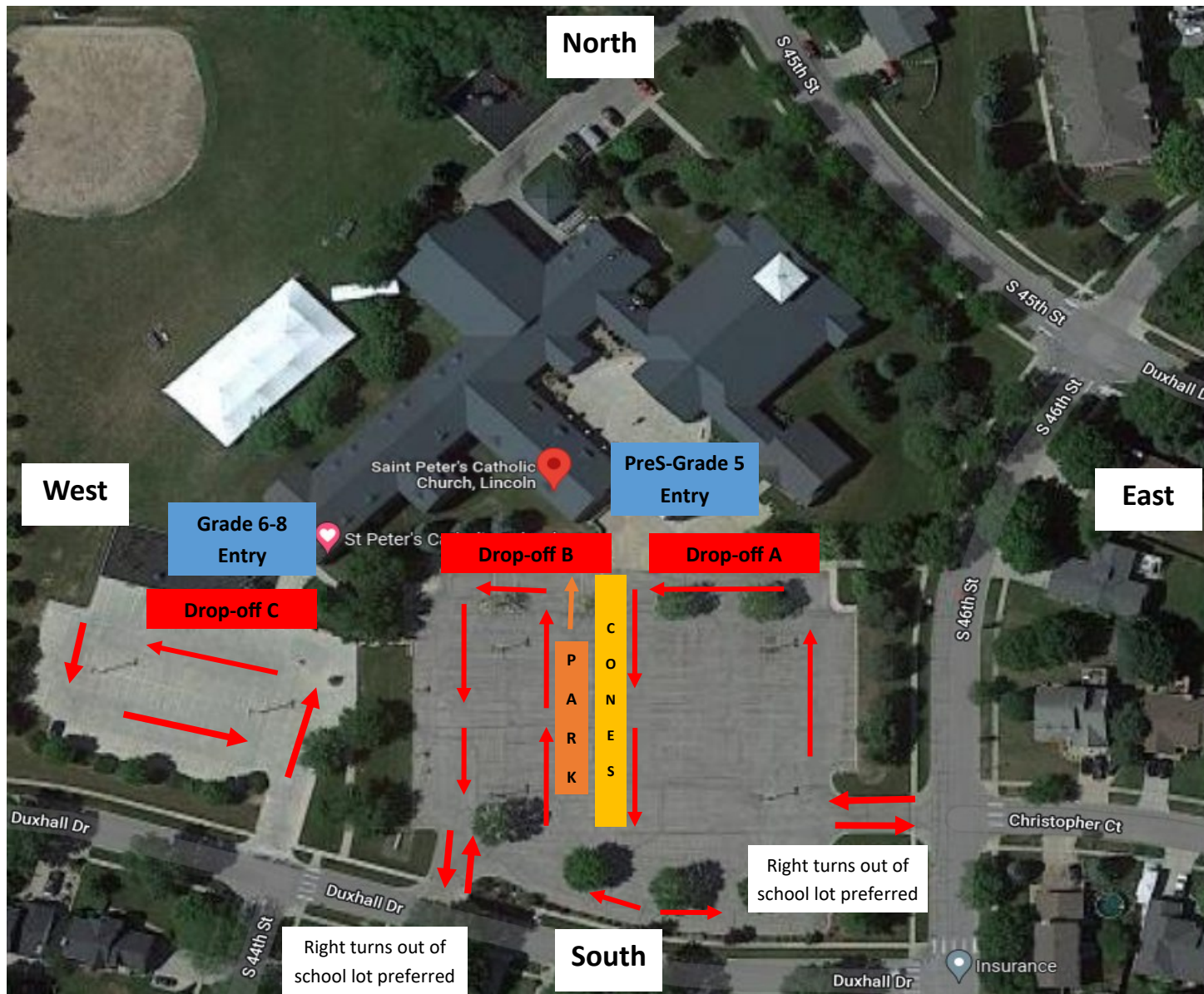

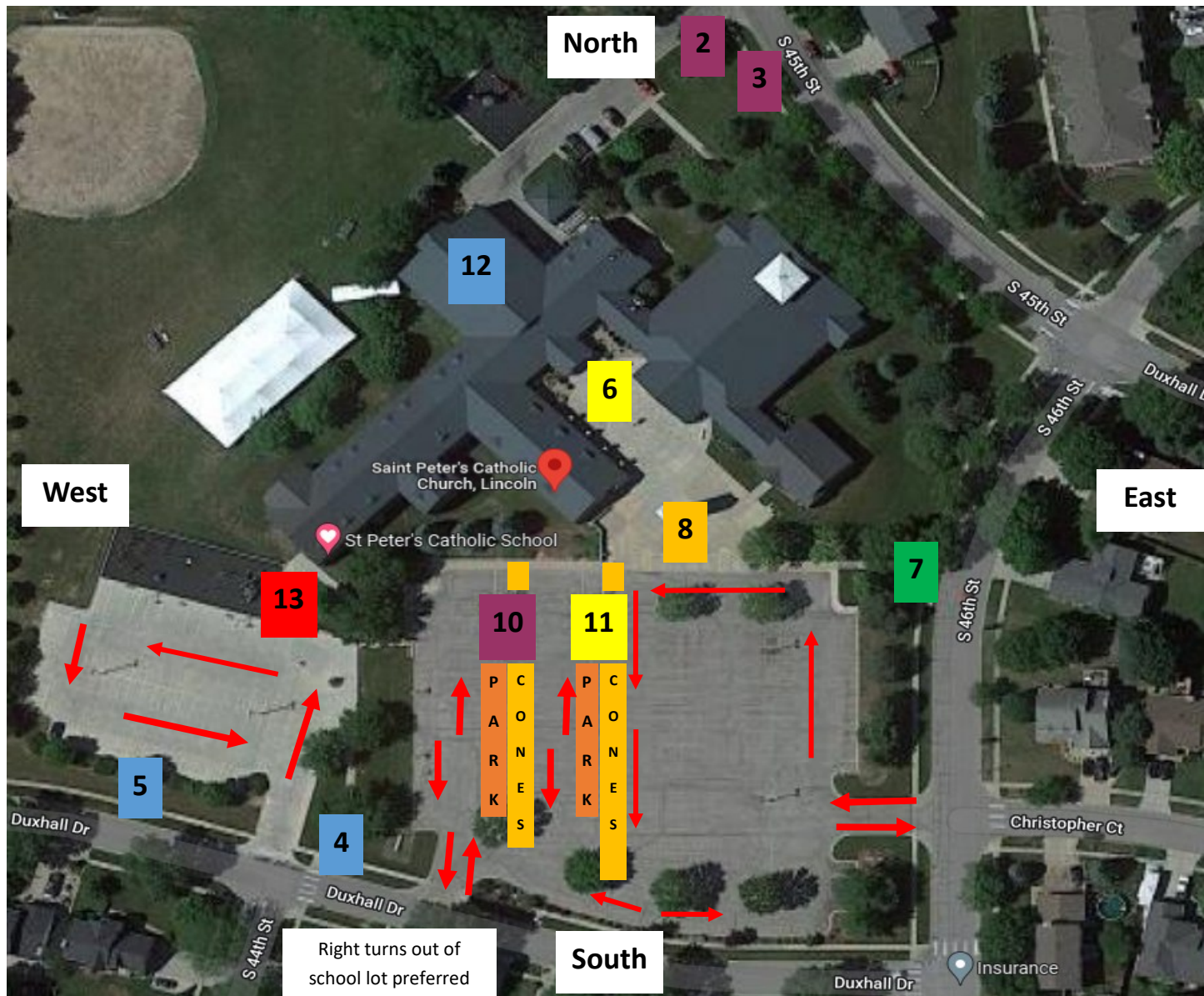


26-27 Student 'End of the Day' Pick-up
