HOMILY NOTES

It was the groom who had the privilege of delaying the bride at the time of Jesus. The wedding could take place anytime within two weeks. So the poor bride had to be in a state of constant alert during those two weeks. However the groom did make it easier for her by sending messengers to her house to warn that he would be coming later that day to pick her up for the wedding. Therefore the bride and groom could not send out invitation cards because only the groom knew when the wedding would be and he gave very little notice. He could choose any day and any hour within those two weeks to come.
